Mountain Maryland Forward (MMF) supports people in recovery from substance use challenges in Maryland's two Appalachian counties of Allegany and Garrett.

The program provides training and internship opportunities to residents of local recovery houses and works with local businesses to link them with employment opportunities. Beyond initial training and placement, MMF gives ongoing assistance through individual mentoring and evaluation activities.

We focus on enhancing partnerships and collaborations with a range of local institutions to identify the unique needs of individuals with a history of substance use disorder (SUD) who are interested in participating in this program and joining the local workforce.
